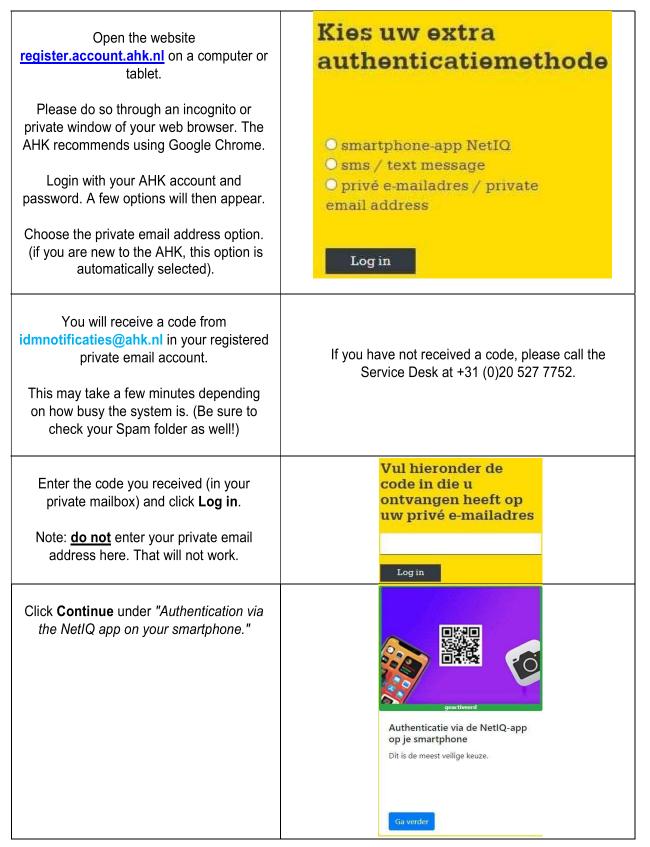

Here, you can use a QR code scanner to download the **NetlQ Advanced Authentication** app to your phone.

You can also search for "NetlQ" on the Play Store / App Store and install the app that way.

If you already have the app installed, click on the blue **"Continue"** button.

Open the NetIQ app on your phone. In the app, press the plus (+) sign to scan the QR code.

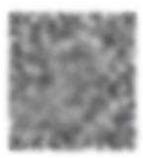
NOTE: The code to the right → has been made unreadable and does not work.

Known Errors

If you cannot log in with the NetlQ app and the page remains yellow, or you see an error message saying "Access prohibited", delete the history and cookies from your browser.

Close all windows of your browser and try again.



If the NetIQ app shows a black screen after scanning the QR code (OR you get an error message from the NetIQ app), uninstall the NetIQ app from your phone and reinstall it from the Play Store or App Store.

Then delete your browser's history and cookies. Close all windows of your browser and try again.

You may not be able to find the NetlQ app in the Play Store or App Store on your phone. In this case, it means that your phone is too old to use the NetlQ app.

In this case, you can try the following:

At the end of the first page of this guide (instead of "Authentication via the NetlQ app"), choose the second option "SMS authentication." Enter your mobile number and click "Send."

NOTE: Start with +316 (or your own country code) instead of 06 when entering your phone number, and enter only numbers (no dashes, spaces, or other symbols).

Example: +31612345678
